You could go with John and Grace to Guayaquil and then proceed as you choose. You could make this trip to be your permanent return to Ecuador, the country of your heart, or to set plans for your permanent residence when you return again, this time for good, this winter.

You will be infinitely happier in Ecuador. The weather will be kinder to you. No matters where you live there, you would not live with Zionists on either side of the house, nor in a town simply littered with Zionists. Of course, your standard of living in Ecuador will be much higher than in New York. Just your Social Security alone will make you an affluent citizen of Ecuador where the average income is about \$600.00 a year.

I know that you are delaying your return to Ecuador because you want to return with a great fortune to establish schools for the children of Ecuador. However, you must know that in any civilization, the money men (as a class) really have a deleterious effect on their country. Consider the RobberBarons of 19th century U.S.A. and the current Wall Street rascals as well as the current unregulated Savings & Loans thieves of our day. It is the builders, the engineers, the scientists, and the thinkers who have made both the U.S.A. and Ecuador.
